Canine OA can be treated with LTCI in dogs one year or older. Studies have demonstrated that lymphocyte subset abnormalities in OA are identical to those in rheumatoid arthritis, suggesting a similar immunological etiology for both joint related diseases. LTCI, provides a safe, alternative to NSAIDS which can be problematic, when mobility is severely compromised.

Lymphocyte T-Cell Immunomodulator (LTCI)

LTCI is supplied in 3-dose or 10-dose packs. LTCI is administered by subcutaneous injection upon diagnosis of Canine OA. Administered in 3 doses in weeks 1 and 2, and 2 doses in weeks 3 and 4. Subsequent injections may be given as necessary monthly or bi-monthly based upon blood results and symptoms.
